² Press and broadcast media are permitted by statute to attend and report on all public meetings of a Parish Council under the Public Bodies (Admission to Meetings) Act 1960 and The Openness of Local Government Bodies Regulations 2014 (including filming and recording) unless an application to exclude them from the meeting during the consideration of specific items of business is made and notified in advance as publicity would be prejudicial to the public interest because of the confidential nature of the business to be transacted. It is to be noted that members of the public all have a right to film and record parish council meetings under the same provision. Live commentary may be prevented if it is disruptive.
